



# Apoteka – Space for Contemporary Art

**Tomislav Gotovac:** *Film by All Means* 22 June - 17 August 2019

The exhibition Tomislav Gotovac: *Film by All Means* at Apoteka - Space for Contemporary Art is compact, as is the space of Apoteka, but it presents several key moments as examples of Gotovac's film thinking *by all means*. The exhibition is organised in cooperation with the Tomislav Gotovac Institute and follows on from the project Cinemaniac: Think Film 2019, a side programme of Pula Film Festival.

# SKUC - Serbian Cultural Centre

*Sonja Savić: A City Girl* 11 - 20 July 2019

### OPENING 11 July / 8 p.m.

Sonja Savić filmed her first author film in 1996, and had starred in more than 40 film and TV roles. Thanks to her massive talent and incredible ability of transformation, she starred in roles that secured her wide popularity and are remembered by generations. Five of her accomplishments, which the audience at Pula will be able to see as part of this multimedia exhibition, can be considered anthological in terms of their significance and artistic value within experimental and alternative film and video production in the territory of former Yugoslavia.

# **VALLI CINEMA**

## *Reinterpretation of the Visual Identity of the 66th Pula Film Festival* by students of the School of Applied Arts and Design, Pula 13- 26 July 2019

The first grade of the School of Applied Arts and Design, Pula, mentored by teacher Denis Sardoz, will join the 66th Pula Film Festival with their reinterpretation of this year's visual identity developed by Marko Rašić. 28 students have joined the project, the first design challenge in their future education. The exhibition will show the students' drawing techniques, their contribution to the 66th Pula Film Festival.

# MEMO Museum

### *Festival of Yugoslavian Film* 13 - 31 July 2019

The exhibition *Festival of Yugoslavian Film* is a new, additional section of the MEMO Museum (Museum of Good Memories). The Museum focuses on everyday life in Pula from the 1950s to the 1980s, and this exhibition will show some of the details of Pula Film Festival in the same period, a time when the Festival was established. Along with photographs, posters, and film recordings, the Museum also owns several items relating to film and cinema, such as cameras, projectors, and screens, which will be exhibited as part of this exhibition.

Visitors with accreditations, passes, and tickets enjoy free entry to the Memo Museum for the duration of the Festival.

### OPENING 14 July / 8 p.m.

Cinemaniac > Think Film is a multi-annual research platform examining the connections between film, moving images and contemporary art, which has been a side programme of Pula Film Festival since 2002. The 18th edition is structured in two parts, as two separate exhibitions, with the addition of screenings and discussions. (15 July / 7 p.m. - book presentation: Lars Henrik Gass: *Film and Art After Cinema*, 8 p.m. - screening of selected films from the International Short Film Festival, Oberhausen)

# Museum of Contemporary Art of Istria / Museo d'arte contemporanea dell'Istria

Goran Trbuljak: Painting (45 Years of Not Painting)

15 July – 1 September 2019

### OPENING: 15 July / 8 p.m.

The exhibition presents 45 years of not painting by Goran Trbuljak, and includes screenings of films by the author. Continuous examination of the museum and gallery system, the roles and positions of the artists and art in the context and perception of modern society, the relationship of the individual toward art, the role of collectors and the market, and considerations of the creation and mission of an art work are primary interests of Trbuljak's visual expression.

# Croatian Association of Interdisciplinary Artists in Pula -Partnership and programme exchange with the Croatian Designers Association in Zagreb CONCEPT BY: MIHAJLO ARSOVSKI - Graphic Design in Books and Journals from 1960s to Today 11 - 31 July 2019

### OPENING: 11 July / 7 p.m.

The exhibition presents the body of work by prominent graphic designer - one of the most significant figures of Croatian graphic design in general, Mihajlo Arsovski, in graphic design of books and scholarly journals, and includes issues designed in the time period from the early 1960s to today. Curators: Dejan Kršić and Marko Golub.

### Jasenko Rasol: *Extras* 11 July – 6 August 2019

### OPENING: 12 July / 9 p.m.

Photographing extras, the people who fill the space *behind* the leading actors in a film, Jasenko Rasol destabilises the hierarchy of the film set where they are just vehicles for a given function.
