Citizens of Rijeka, which Italians call Fiume, retell, reconstruct and reinterpret the bizarre story of the 16-month occupation of their city in 1919 by the Italian poet, a dandy and preacher of war, Gabriele D'Annunzio.

Igor Bezinović (1983), graduated in philosophy, sociology and comparative literature from the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zagreb and film and TV directing from the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. He directed the films *Blockade* (Oktavijan Award for Best Croatian Documentary Film in 2012), *Veruda* (Oktavijan Award for Best Croatian Documentary Film in 2015), and *A Brief Excursion* (Grand Golden Arena for Best Croatian Feature Film in 2017), and several short films of various types and lengths. His films have been screened at international festivals in Rotterdam, Leipzig, Ji.hlava, and Guanajuato, as well as Biennale des jeunes créateurs de l'Europe et de la Méditerranée and the International Architecture Exhibition in Venice (with Hrvoslava Brkušić for the Pula group), and the Museum of the Moving Image in New York.

Igor Bezinović (1983.), diplomirao je filozofiju, sociologiju i komparativnu književnost na Filozofskom fakultetu u Zagrebu te filmsku i televizijsku režiju na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti u Zagrebu. Režirao je filmove *Blokada* (Oktavijan za najbolji hrvatski dokumentarni film 2012. godine), *Veruda* (Oktavijan za najbolji hrvatski dokumentarni film 2015. godine) i *Kratki izlet* (Velika zlatna arena za najbolji hrvatski dugometražni igrani film 2017. godine), kao i niz kratkih filmova raznih vrsta i trajanja. Njegovi su filmovi i radovi prikazivani na međunarodnim filmskim festivalima u Rotterdamu, Leipzigu, Jihlavi i Guanajuatu te na Bijenalu mladih umjetnika Europe i Mediterana, Bijenalu arhitekture u Veneciji (s Hrvoslavom Brkušić za Pulsku grupu) i njujorškom Muzeju pokretnih slika.

This documentary film follows the life of men from Dugi otok and their unusual endeavours: Vedran (60) is building replicas of Egyptian pyramids in the olive groves, Sebastijan (30) is unsuccessfully attempting to erect a huge cross on top of a hill, Bila (65) is trying to sell his van that is impossible to be sold, Rino (55) is operating boat tours, but can't catch a break, and David (10) and Lukas (6) are constantly looking for fun and kids to hang out with on an island that is lacking in both.

Ivan Grgur is a 2019 graduate of the Restart School of Documentary Film. He made his first short documentary film *Probably Dead* in the same year. He then enrolled into the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. He is currently making his graduating film *Men on the Island*, while his third short documentary film *Rade Saves the Season* is in postproduction.

Goran Dević (1971) studied law and archeology, and graduated in film and TV directing from the Academy of Dramatic Arts in Zagreb, where he teaches film and TV directing at the undergraduate and graduate studies as associate professor. He wrote and directed some twenty documentary and fiction films, and is the co-writer and director of the feature film *The Blacks*. He is the author of awarded documentary films.

Ovaj dokumentarni film prati život muškaraca s Dugog Otoka i njihove neuobičajene pothvate; Vedran (60) gradi replike egipatskih piramida u masliniku, Sebastijan (30) neuspješno pokušava podići ogroman križ na vrhu brda, Bile (65) pokušava prodati kombi koji je nemoguće prodati, Rino (55) vozi turističke ture brodom, ali mu ništa ne ide od ruke, a David (10) i Lukas (6) konstantno traže zabavu i društvo na otoku koji oskudijeva i jednim i drugim.

Ivan Grgur završio je 2019. godine Restartovu školu dokumentarnog filma i snimio svoj prvi kratkometražni dokumentarni film *Sigurno mrtvi*. Zatim je upisao Akademiju dramskih umjetnosti u Zagrebu. Trenutačno snima svoj diplomski film *Muški na otoku* te je u postprodukciji svog trećeg kratkometražnog dokumentarnog filma, *Rade spašava sezonu*.



BLACK SWAN

AUTHOR: Hrvoje Hribar

A village girl gets to higher politics, a banker from Zagreb to the branch office at the village. At the foothills of the D Mountain in N-ska County, a deep spring. A robust man flings a money counting machine into the water, and proceeds to take out a hunting rifle from the trunk of his car and kills himself. The central bank sends a replacement, Janko Boris Labud, who makes it just in time for the funeral. He has a new money counting machine and assumes responsibility for the branch office, but with it also for a whole host of characters surrounding it. The commission states that the deceased banker has left the safe completely empty save for a green notebook containing information that can cost a lot of people their life. Janko hides the notebook from the investigators so he could get to know the county prefect Anica Kralj better. He makes a decision to continue to help her, in his own way and following his own rules.

Hrvoje Hribar is a film director and producer. He graduated in film directing from the Academy of Dramatic Art. He produced and directed the comedy *What Is a Man Without a Moustache?* (2005), the most watched Croatian film of the 2000s, and wrote, directed and produced two documentary films before that (*The World Is Great*, 1999 and *Once There Was a Man*, 2001), as well as his feature debut *The Tranquilizer Gun* (1997). He directed and wrote the TV film *Croatian Cathedrals* (1992) and the short film *Between Zaghlul and Zaharias* (1994). In 2001, he directed the TV series *New Age* for Croatian Radiotelevision. He won the Oktavijan Award for Best Film a number of times (*The Tranquilizer Gun*, *Once There Was a Man* and *Between Zaghlul and Zaharias*). Since November 2008, he has been serving as a member of the Executive Committee of the Federation of European Screen Directors, and from September 2010 to February 2017 he was the Chief Executive Officer of the Croatian Audiovisual Centre. He is a member of the Croatian Film Directors' Guild and the Croatian Producers Association. In 2011 he won the Albert Kapović Award of the Croatian Producers Association for his contribution to Croatian film, and in 2013 he was awarded the Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters by the French Ministry of Culture for his contribution to cultural cooperation and strengthening the ties between the Croatian and French audiovisual sector.

Hrvoje Hribar filmski je redatelj i producent. Diplomirao filmsku režiju na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti. Producirao je i režirao filmsku komediju *Što je muškarac bez brkova?* (2005.), najgledaniji hrvatski film u prvom desetljeću novog tisućljeća, a prije toga napisao je, režirao i producirao dva dokumentarna filma (*Svijet je velik*, 1999. i *Bil jedan*, 2001.) te svoj dugometražni prvijenac *Puška za uspavlivanje* (1997.). Kao redatelj i scenarist, autor je televizijskog filma *Hrvatske katedrale* (1992.) te kratkometražnog filma *Između Zaghlula i Zaharias* (1994.). 2001. za HRT je režirao seriju *Novo doba*. Višestruki je dobitnik nagrade Oktavijan za najbolji film godine (*Puška za uspavlivanje*, *Bil jedan*, *Između Zaghlula i Zaharias*). Od studenog 2008. član je Izvršnog odbora Federacije europskih filmskih redatelja, a od rujna 2010. do veljače 2017. bio je ravnatelj Hrvatskog audiovizualnog centra. Član je Hrvatskog društva filmskih redatelja i Hrvatske udruge producenata. 2011. primio je Nagradu Albert Kapović Hrvatske udruge producenata za doprinos hrvatskome filmu, a 2013. godine visoko odličje francuske vlade za kulturu – Vitez reda umjetnosti i književnosti za svoje zasluge u međukulturnoj suradnji i jačanju veza hrvatskog i francuskog audiovizualnog sektora.

He works as screenwriter on film and TV projects, and also as screenwriter, director, actor, and producer on short films. He has gained additional experience at numerous workshops and pitching forums (Palunko, Film School of Kino Klub Split, Sitcom Media Pro organised by Nova TV, Croatian Film Days, Croatian Short Pitch - Diversions, ZagrebDox pitching). He is one of the founders, teaching coordinator, and lecturer at the Screenwriting School Palunko of the Croatian Film Association. He is a member of Kino klub Split, Blank_filmski incubator Association, and the Croatian Screenwriters and Playwrights Guild. He won the award for social innovation and various special mentions for his volunteer work.

One night he receives a request from the client Sara, who needs to be picked up outside the entrance to the festival and taken to the city. At first, Toni accepts the request, but then declines it when another group offers more money for a ride to their hotel. The next day he sees the police at the festival grounds investigating a case related to the missing young girl.

Filip Heraković (1989) graduated in dramaturgy from the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. He wrote and directed several short films screened at domestic and international film festivals. His first feature film, *Pelican*, premiered at Tallinn Black Nights Film Festival, where it received the special jury prize. *Pelican* also won the award for best film in the Brave Balkans section at the Auteur Film Festival in Belgrade. He is currently completing his short fiction film *Crocodile's Teeth*, which received support from the Croatian Audiovisual Centre at the public call for stimulating production. He is also developing the short fiction film *Night Waves*. He is a member of the European Film Academy, Croatian Film Directors' Guild, and Plafon Arts Organisation.

Film je smješten u okruženje taksista koji rade noćne smjene u vrijeme velikih festivala elektronske glazbe kakvi se organiziraju na hrvatskoj obali tijekom ljeta. Glavni lik je Toni, sezonski radnik koji, nakon što dobije otkaz, igrom slučaja preuzima posao vozača Ubera. Jedne noći primi zahtjev za vožnju klijentice Sare koju treba pokupiti kod ulaza na festival i vratiti je do grada. Isprva prihvaća zahtjev, ali ga zatim otkazuje nakon što mu jedna druga grupa ponudi više novaca za prijevoz do hotela. Sljedećeg dana, ugleda policiju kako vrši izvide na festivalskom terenu povezane s nestankom te mlade djevojke.

Filip Heraković (1989.), diplomirao je filmsku i televizijsku režiju na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti u Zagrebu. Napisao je i režirao nekoliko kratkih filmova prikazanih na domaćim i regionalnim filmskim festivalima. Prvi dugometražni igrani film *Pelikan* premijerno mu je prikazana na festivalu „Black Nights“ u Tallinnu gdje je osvojio posebnu nagradu žirija za režiju. Na Festivalu autorskog filma u Beogradu, *Pelikan* je osvojio i nagradu za najbolji film u sekciji „Hrabri Balkan“. Trenutačno završava i kratki igrani film *Zubi krokodila* koji je dobio potporu HAVC-a na Javnom pozivu za poticanje proizvodnje. Razvija i dugometražni igrani film *Noćni valovi*. Član je Europske filmske akademije, Društva hrvatskih filmskih redatelja i Umjetničke organizacije Plafon.

RHINO

Lying idly on the couch, Raks hears a TV report on the scourge of rhinos in Africa and the smuggling of their horns into the illegal Chinese market. Powder from rhino horns is considered an aphrodisiac in China and is sold at soaring prices. Raks devises a plan to get a rhino in Zagreb and informs his friends Živko and Bara. After unsuccessfully looking for a taxidermied head of a rhino in unguarded museums, hunting lodges and Tito's abandoned residences, Raks, Živko and Bara give up their naive idea. Soon afterwards, a TV report talks about a politician who has been arrested and his secret bunker full of illicit works of art and hunting trophies. The photo of the politician taken on safari captures their attention. They decide to brake into the bunker.

Dubravka Turić (1973) graduated in film and TV editing from the Academy of Dramatic Art in Zagreb. She is a director, editor, and screenwriter. Her first project, the short fiction film *Belladonna*, won the Golden Lion for Best Short Film at Venice Film Festival in 2015. It was also the first Croatian film at Sundance Film Festival. Her second feature fiction film, *Cherries* (2017), premiered at Directors' Fortnight in Cannes in 2017, and her film *Tina* (2019) premiered at Sarajevo Film Festival. Her first feature film, *Traces*, had its world premiere at the Warsaw Film Festival in 2022, and is still in festival distribution. She has worked as editor on more than 30 films and 200 commercials, and has worked as screenwriter, other than on her own films, on documentary TV series *Svlačionica*, *Mjenjačnica*, *Koledžicom po svijetu* and others. She is a member of the Filmmakers Association of Croatia and the Croatian Freelance Artists' Association.

MIRROR OF NIGHTINGALES

The story of Dora, professional weeper, the best in the village - when she weeps, even the dead cry. One day Dora is late and cries at the wrong cemetery. Her business is dead, and her reputation ruined. Desperately looking for crying gigs, Dora meets Dunda, a man who desperately wants to die, but can't. Two people between life and death, Dora and Dunda need each other: if Dora helps Dunda to die, he will get her a gig, the ultimate gig in the village. However, their love leads to an unexpected turn of events, and Dunda will be able to die, while Dora will finally be able to live.

NOSOROG

AUTORICA: Dubravka Turić

Dok besposlen leži na kauču, Raks preko priloga na TV-u saznaje za pomor nosoroga u Africi i krijumčarenje njihovih rogova na kineskom ilegalnom tržištu. Prah od roga tamo se smatra afrodizijakom i dostiže milijunske iznose. Raks smisli plan kako u Zagrebu jednostavno doći do nosoroga i o tome obavještava svoje prijatelje, Živka i Baru. Nakon bezuspješnog traženja preparirane glave nosoroga po nečuvanim muzejima, lovačkim domovima i Titovim napuštenim rezidencijama, Raks, Živko i Bara odustanu od naivne ideje. Uskoro na TV-u vide prilog o uhićenom političaru i njegovom tajnom bunkeru sa sumnjivo stečenim umjetninama i lovačkim trofejima. Najviše im zaokupi pažnju njegova fotografija sa safarija. Odluče provaliti u bunker.

Dubravka Turić (1973.), diplomirala je filmsku i TV montažu na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti u Zagrebu. Profesionalno se bavi režijom, montažom i pisanjem scenarija. Njezin prvi autorski projekt, kratki igrani film *Belladonna*, osvojio je Zlatnog lava za najbolji kratkometražni igrani film na Filmskom festivalu u Veneciji 2015. Film je također bio i prvi hrvatski predstavnik na Filmskom festivalu Sundance. Njezin drugi kratkometražni film, *Trešnje*, premijerno je prikazan u Cannesu u sekciji Quinzaine des realisateurs 2017., a *Tina* na Filmskom festivalu u Sarajevu 2019. Njezin prvi dugometražni film *Tragovi* svjetsku premijeru imao je na Filmskom festivalu u Varšavi 2022. i još je uvijek u festivalskoj distribuciji. Kao montažerka, radila je na više od 30 filmova i 200 reklamnih spotova, a kao scenaristica, osim na svojim filmovima, radila je i na dokumentarnim televizijskim serijalima *Svlačionica*, *Mjenjačnica*, *Koledžicom po svijetu* i ostalima. Članica je Hrvatskog društva filmskih djelatnika i Hrvatske zajednice samostalnih umjetnika.

Priča o Dori, profesionalnoj narikači, najboljoj u selu – kad ona cvili, i mrtvi plaču. Jednoga dana, Dora kasni i plače na krivom grobu. Njezin posao je sada mrtav, a ugled uništen. U očajničkoj potrazi za gažama plakanja, Dora upozna Dundu, čovjeka koji očajnički želi, ali ne može umrijeti. Dvoje ljudi između života i smrti, Dora i Dunda trebaju jedno drugo: ako Dora pomogne Dundi da umre, on će joj osigurati gažu, ultimativnu gažu u selu. Međutim, njihova ljubav odvest će ih u neočekivan razvoj događaja, te će Dunda moći umrijeti, a Dora konačno moći živjeti.

Karla Lulić is a screenwriter and producer. She graduated in cinema and TV production at Sorbonne. She was the president of the Cultural Council of the City of Koprivnica for two terms. She has successfully realised and produced three awarded short fiction films, and her latest, *Ostrižena*, is soon going into distribution. Her first independent films, *In the Name of the Strawberry*, *the Chocolate and the Holy Spirit* and *Following...* have been awarded and screened at a number of domestic and international festivals. She also gained experience at the Paris production company Clandestine films, where she worked as production assistant and coordinator, and at Nova TV, where she worked as head of Research, Development and Planning on-air. She worked as producer on the debut feature project *Emergency Exit* by awarded director Bogdan Muresanu. Her debut feature film in advance stage of development, the dark folk comedy *Mirror for Nightingales*, is supported by the MEDIA fund, the Croatian Audiovisual Centre and the City of Koprivnica. She is the founder of the company Dobar film, and is a member of the Croatian Screenwriters and Playwrights Guild and the Croatian Film Directors' Guild.

THE WINDOW ACROSS THE STREET

While giving an exclusive interview about banks stealing one hundred million euros from Croatian citizens at the studio of the news portal Index, Sanja Mehinović (53) had no idea what would make her cry. The window across the street from the studio, where the most famous investigative reporter Ilko Čimić (47) was waiting for her, was the window of her office, where she spent months printing out materials to prove that Raiffeisen Leasing Bank, headed by Izidora Juroš (54), defrauded its clients. Sanja's apartment was buried under tens of thousands of printed pages, proof, for months, and she was harassed about it, on medication, and intimidated because of it, but was able to prove the biggest bank fraud in these parts.

Katarina Zrinka Matijević (1973) is a film director and screenwriter. She graduated in film and TV directing from the Academy of Dramatic Art and in philosophy and comparative literature from the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zagreb. Her awarded student film *Duel* (1998) gained her attention. Her first professional documentary film, *On Cows and Men* (2002, co-directed by Nebojša Slijepčević), was screened at major international festivals such as IDFA, Munich, etc. In 2003 she filmed *Peščenopolis*. Her documentary film *A Two Way Mirror* (2016) received the Oktavijan Award and was

Dok je u studiju portala Index davala ekskluzivan intervju o tome kako su banke hrvatskim građanima ukrale sto milijuna eura Sanja Mehinović (53) nije slutila što će je rasplakati. Prozor preko puta studija, u kojem ju je čekao najpoznatiji istraživački novinar Ilko Čimić (47), bio je prozor njezinog ureda u kojem je mjesecima u strahu printala materijale kojima će dokazati prevaru Raiffeisen Leasing Banke pod vodstvom Izidore Juroš (54). Sanjin stan bio je mjesecima zatrpan s desecima tisuća ispisanih dokaza zbog kojih je bila šikanirana, na lijekovima i zastrašivana, ali s kojima je dokazala najveću bankarsku pljačku na ovim prostorima.

Katarina Zrinka Matijević (1973.), filmska je redateljica i scenaristica. Diplomirala je filmsku i TV režiju na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti te filozofiju i komparativnu književnost na Filozofskom fakultetu u Zagrebu. Prvi put na sebe skreće pozornost nagrađivanim studentskim filmom *Dvoboj* (1998.). Njezin prvi profesionalni dokumentarac, *O Kravama i ljudima* (2002., suredatelj Nebojša Slijepčević), prikazan je na važnim međunarodnim festivalima kao što su IDFA, München itd. 2003. snima *Peščenopolis*. Forty-year-old Viktorija is a homely, withdrawn, and frustrated virgin who is treated as a maid by her dominant and narcissistic mother Fabijanka. When Fabijanka suddenly has a serious stroke, Viktorija realises that she will lose all her freedom if she brings her mother back to the apartment. With support from her boss, old widower and owner of antique shop, Lucijan, she makes the decision of her life and puts her mother in a hospice. Haunted by a sense of guilt, but also excited about her newfound freedom, she goes out to experience life and acts like a teenager: she dyes her hair for the first time, gets waxed, sees a gynaecologist, buys feminine clothes, takes a yoga class, consumes stories about sex, tries to find female friends, takes her own virginity, and goes on a speed date.

Luka Galešić (1991) studied journalism at the Faculty of Political Science and dramaturgy at the Academy of Dramatic Art, and in 2016 enrolled into film and TV editing at the Academy, where he is currently in his last year of his graduate studies in fiction film. As a student of dramaturgy, he received the Rector's Award for his regional project *Justice*. He worked as an associate on the screenplay of the feature film *Lada Kamenski*, directed by Sara Hribar and Marko Šantić. For the past three years he has been working as assistant director on Croatian films and series such as *The Diary of Paulina P.*, *The Head of a Big Fish*, *The Staffroom*, *Sixth Bus*, etc. He is currently working on his debut fiction film *Viktorija*.

Nakon što Fabijanka iznenada doživi ozbiljan moždani udar, Viktorija shvaća da ako majku vrati u stan, gubi svoju slobodu u potpunosti. Uz podršku svog šefa Lucijana, starog udovca i vlasnika antikvarijata, donosi odluku života i smješta majku u dom za nemoćne. Progonjena osjećajem krivnje, ali i uzbuđenjem zbog novonastale slobode, kreće u naglu konzamaciju života i ponaša se kao prava tinejdžerica: prvi put farba kosu, depilira se, posjećuje ginekologinju, kupuje ženstvenu odjeću, upisuje jogu, upija priče o seksu, pokušava steći prijateljice, razdjevičuje samu sebe i odlazi na speed date.

Luka Galešić (1991.), nakon studija novinarstva na Fakultetu političkih znanosti i studija dramaturgije na Akademiji dramske umjetnosti, 2016. upisuje filmsku i TV režiju na istoj akademiji na kojoj završava posljednju godinu diplomskog studija, smjer igrani film.
